

5th WCC-APR Board Meeting, 11th April 2019, Chiang Mai-Thailand

The WCC-APR 5th Board Meeting was held in Chiang Mai University from 8.30 am to 4 pm. There was a good attendance, which made the meeting successful.

The meeting was opened with welcoming speeches by two Chiang Mai dignitaries: the Deputy Governor of Chiang Mai Province-Mr.Wiroon Phromthavee, and the Associate Professor Rome Chiranukrom-Vice President for International Relations and Alumni Affairs, who were accompanied by the host, the Director of Social Research Institute, Chiang Mai University-Dr.Woralun Boonyasurat.
