- copperplate engraving on bones, Omani hat, silk fabric and others.








About new design of crafts:

- Questionnaires were given to craft alongside the review of the most prominent of information and electronic data craft .




HE Chairperson of PACI receives Chairman of the Committee of Uzbek

Unfortunately for the second consecutive year craft exhibits and events have been at a standstill due to the difficult security conditions in Lebanon.

MGO's that usually organize these craft events, have cut short the period to one single day and have transformed the exhibits to accompany some philanthropic events be it a brunch or "fotoor" due to the security procedures depending on the buying force of members or participants (attached photo, an exhibit at a one day breakfast event at hotel Phoenicia).

Exhibited items varied between glass paintings, tailoring, embroidery and some needlework, woodworks, children chairs, throw pillows, in addition to numerous fake jewelry due to the price of gold.

These exhibits were directly linked to the season of "Hajj", Christmas and New Year among others.

Many organizations come together to perform these one or two days craft events.
